## Nutrition Support

In addition to our Weekend Meal and Self-Serve programs, **WIN provides healthy food throughout our community** to partners who provide services and programs for children and teens. Whether it be snack support for teachers and counselors in the South Whidbey School District or lunch items for teens participating in an alternative program, WIN is committed to ensuring that South Whidbey young people have the healthy food they need to thrive.

### Weekend Meal Program

For children who rely on the free or reduced cost lunch program during the week or those in need of supplemental nutrition, WIN's Weekend Meal Program provides enrolled children & teens two healthy lunches each week to be consumed over the weekend or when school is not in session.

### Self-Serve

For older youth and others in need, WIN has ready-to-eat sack lunches available upon request at the Good Cheer Food Bank

#### Ryan's House for Youth

Providing a safe nurturing environment for homeless youth on Whidbey Island. **Receives grocery items.**

#### Whidbey Homeless Coalition/House of Hope

Providing transitional housing for families who are homeless or at risk of homelessness. **Receives grocery items.**

#### Family Resource Center/Readiness to Learn

Offering programs, resources and support for South Whidbey youth and their families. **Receives sack lunches and ala carte lunch items.**

#### South Whidbey Children's Center

A highly accredited, nonprofit, early childhood education center serving families from diverse financial backgrounds. **Receives ala carte lunch items.**

#### The HUB

An after-school drop-in program offering social and recreational activities for middle and high school youth in a safe, supportive setting. **Receives grocery items.**

#### South Whidbey Academy

An alternative High School Program serving the South Whidbey School District. **Receives ala carte snack & lunch items.**

#### South Whidbey School District

WIN provides a fresh fruit & vegetable snack program for all students at the SW Elementary School. **All schools also receive ala carte lunch items and snack support.**

#### Good Cheer Food Bank

Committed to providing a hunger-free community. **Receives sack lunches.**
